SEEKING GOD THROUGH HIS WORD

- Matthew 6:25-33
 - What does it mean to seek God's Kingdom and His righteousness first?
- Acts 17:22-28
 - We want to know the real God. There is nothing more important than knowing our Creator.

So how do we seek Him?

WITH ALL OF OUR HEART

- Jeremiah 29:11-13
 - Have you ever done anything with all your heart?
 - What is God's promise if we seek him with all of our heart?
 - That we will find him.
- Acts 8:26-40
 - Describe this man who was seeking God.

THROUGH THE WRITTEN WORD

- 2 Timothy 3:16-17
 - How are the scriptures described? From God; useful.
 - "Thoroughly equipped" nothing else is needed (manuals, creeds, traditions, church covenants, special dreams or revelations).
- Hebrews 4:12-13
 - How is it described: Living and active (useful). Like a sword.
 - The Word cuts (hurts) compare it to a scalpel. It's good to be cut because it cuts the "cancer" (sin) out, but even good cuts can hurt.
 - Am I willing to let the Word cut on me? Even if it hurts?
- John 12:47-50
 - Why study the Bible?
 - The Word will judge us on the last day. Ignorance will not be an excuse on Judgment Day.
 - Am I willing to let the Bible be the standard for my life and doctrine?

THROUGH THE LIVING WORD

- John 1:1-4,14
 - Who is he talking about here? What did Jesus come to show us?
- Hebrews 1:1-3
 - Jesus shows us exactly who God is.
